Change to the Norfolk District's State Program General Permit (SPGP-01)

On July 26, 2004, the Norfolk District issued a public notice, after providing an opportunity for public review and comment, announcing that the District's regional conditions to the Corps Nationwide Permits have been amended to require the countersinking of pipes and culverts associated with road crossings of nontidal waters unless certain conditions exist. All projects not proposing the use of countersunk pipes or culverts require the submission of a preconstruction notification (PCN).

The requirement is effective on September 1, 2004 and will apply to all SPGP-01 permit applications received after that date and those pending on that date. The specific requirements can be found at <http://www.nao.usace.army.mil/Regulatory/2002NWpermits/NWPgrid.htm>.
